“The Joint Fundraising Raffle” Sweepstakes (the “Sweepstakes”) begins 9/15/09; ends 1/20/2010. Entry must be received by date specified elsewhere in offer or by prize deadline(s) below, whichever is sooner. This Sweepstakes may be presented in different creative presentations by different organizations (“Presenting Promoters”).

1. HOW TO ENTER

Submit your Ticket between 9/15/09 and 1/20/10 according to the instructions that you receive. Indicate your choice of the donation options set forth below and your choice of payment method.

2. ELIGIBILITY
